

USE OF THE UNIFORM IN BELL-LLOC

1. Bell-lloc is a school which uses a uniform.
2. The use of uniform allows the students to identify with the school, it helps building team spirit and it is also a cost-effective and elegant dressing code. Another important reason is to avoid judgment of others due to their external appearance.
3. Wearing the school uniform is compulsory during all the school hours and also during the transport service. Any exception on wearing the uniform must be informed to the corresponding head of section.
4. The CEI (Centre d'Educació Infantil) has its own uniform.
5. Uniform characteristics for the students from 1st of primary education to 4th of ESO:
 - a. Dark blue jersey with Bell-lloc's emblem.
 - b. Garnet polo shirt with Bell-lloc's emblem.
 - c. Grey dress pants.
 - d. Dark socks.
 - e. Black shoes (it is recommended not to use ridged soles as they gather dust and mud that dirties school facilities and your own homes)
 - f. Jacket for outdoor activities.
6. Uniform characteristics for students in Batxillerat:
 - a. Shirt.
 - b. Polo.
 - c. Grey dress pants.
 - d. Dark socks.
 - e. Black shoes (it is recommended not to use ridged soles as they gather dust and mud that dirties school facilities and your own homes)
 - f. Jacket for outdoor activities.
